

PHYSICS INSTRUCTOR

Successful applicants must demonstrate exceptional ability and innovation in teaching. Additional duties will include maintenance and supervision of undergraduate physics laboratories and equipment. An MS or PhD in Physics, Applied Physics, or a very closely related field is required. The College is especially interested in qualified candidates who can contribute, through their teaching and/or service, to the diversity and excellence of the academic community.
