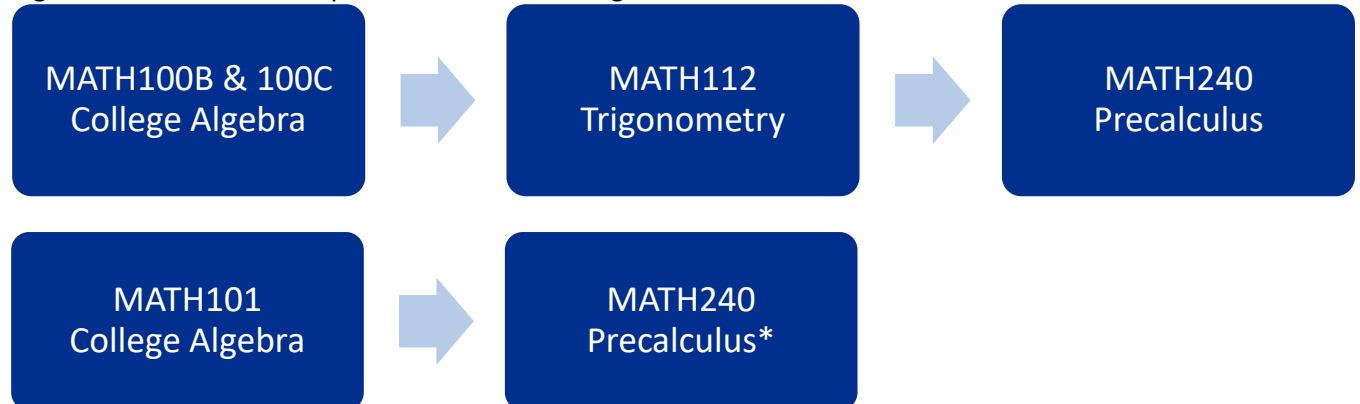
Course Placement	
<b>Math ACT 19-21</b> <b>Math SAT* 500-540</b>	MATH 100B & 100C: Expanded College Algebra
<b>Math ACT 22-25</b> <b>Math SAT* 550-600</b>	MATH 101: College Algebra
<b>Math ACT <math>\geq 26</math></b> <b>Math SAT* <math>\geq 610</math></b>	MATH 112: Trigonometry OR MATH 240: Pre-Calculus, as appropriate (Credit for MATH 101 is given.)

*\*SAT scores before March 2016 test date will be discussed on a case by case basis.*

Math ACT  $\geq 26$  (Math SAT\*  $\geq 610$ ) or accepted dual enrollment credit for the prerequisite math courses is required in order to start in the engineering and computer science courses.
